## A - exercises

- 1. Look at a map of the world. Where is Norway?
- 2. Make a map of the countries that the Vikings visited and the routes that they sailed.
- 3. Briefly describe the major events in the history of Norway? Make a time line that lists all the changes that took place.
- 4. Trees play an important role in Norse mythology. Where in their mythology do we find trees and why are they so important?
- 5. According to the Norse creation myth, trees come into existence in different ways. List some of these ways.
- 6. What are the characteristics that the Norse gods share?
- 7. What is the difference between Ginnungagap, Midgard and Asgard?
- 8. In most myths there is nothing in the beginning. What did nothing look like according to the Norse creation myth?
- 9. Why did Odin create human beings?
- 10. What similarities do you see between the Norse creation myth and those of other cultures?

## **B** - exercises

Look at a few websites that deal with this culture and choose one or two that have images, sounds or text that you think are useful for preparing your presentation. Make a summary or a sketch of the Norse creation myth on a piece of flip chart paper. As much as possible, try to use the illustrations and images you found on the internet.

Choose one of the following exercises:
